


# Christchurch & Canterbury

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# Day one: Explore Christchurch

## Day two: Early bird gets the view

## Day five: Fly into wine country

Enrich your wine making knowledge with a guided vineyard tour at Greystone then finish your afternoon with the ultimate truffle experience at Kings Truffles.
